

The focus of the special issue is on the development of the DEA methodology and its applications to performance management in all segments of the public sector. Note that straightforward applications of DEA and pure methodology papers that do not show relevance to the public sector would be out of the scope of the journal.

While this special issue is devoted for best papers presented in the DEA2015 conference, it is also open to authors not presenting at this conference.
